WHAT CAN I IMPROVE?

1. I could pay more attention to gender and number agreement between nouns and adjectives, and number agreement between nouns and verbs.	
2. I could try to think about the reasons why I choose a particular verb, or a verb form, before committing it to writing. Especially important when dealing with verbs such as TO BE, which can translate into SER, ESTAR, TENER, HABER.	
3. I could make sure I include as wide a variety as possible of verbs and words that are key to the topic I am writing about, to show I am well prepared and make good use of what I have learnt, and I am supposed to know at this level, at this point in time into my course/module/independent-learning approach.	
4. I could try to make a point of using other words besides or instead of the ones given in a model presentation (this would give me a chance to experiment further with the grammar and expand/ learn vocabulary within a particular topic/context).	
5. I could try to pay more attention to the requirements set for the writing I am expected to do, as these would be some of the criteria my writing will be marked against in the context of summative assessment. Anything else you would add to your list?
